- The AFL Cup is a modified version of AFL Football that is played on Rugby sized fields with 9 players on the field and unlimited interchange, recommend minimum 3 reserves.
- Resources such as goal posts, cones, and umpires will be provided by AFL New Zealand.
- Transport, numbered uniforms, drink bottles and team medical equipment to be organised by schools.
- Please ensure each student completes a registration form prior to the first Regional Cluster match. Individual Player registrations and details need to be complete providing participants opportunities to continue the AFL Pathway participating in the AFLNZ Youth Competition and progressing to potential National Representation.
- Cluster regional tournaments are a one-day tournament where teams will play in the round robin event against all other teams present. The team winning the most games or going to points for and against to determine the regional cluster tournament winners.
- With entry to the AFL Cup competition all teams are eligible for North or South Island championships dependant on location. Entry form must however be completed with Principals signature.

Secondary School AFL Cup fees

- Option 1: \$180 + GST
Includes:
 - School entry – as many teams, boys and girls for
 1. AFL Cup regional tournament
 2. North or South Island Championship
 - Up to six promotion/training sessions
 - Entry AFL Cup tournament day
 - Entry North or South Island Championships
 - Entry needs to be completed, signed and returned with preferred in school training session dates and times booked and confirmed prior to starting the in-school training sessions or promotion sessions.
- Option 2: \$90 + GST
Includes:
 - School entry – as many teams, boys and girls for
 1. AFL Cup regional tournament
 2. North or South Island Championship
 - Entry AFL Cup tournament day
 - Entry North or South Island Championships
